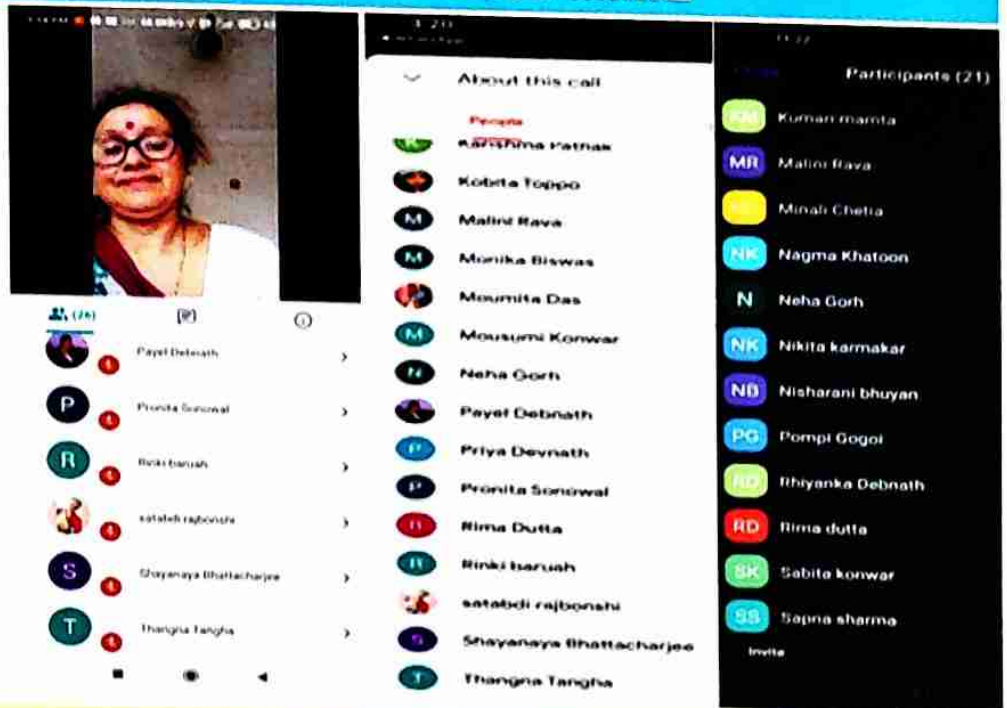
## FRESHERS

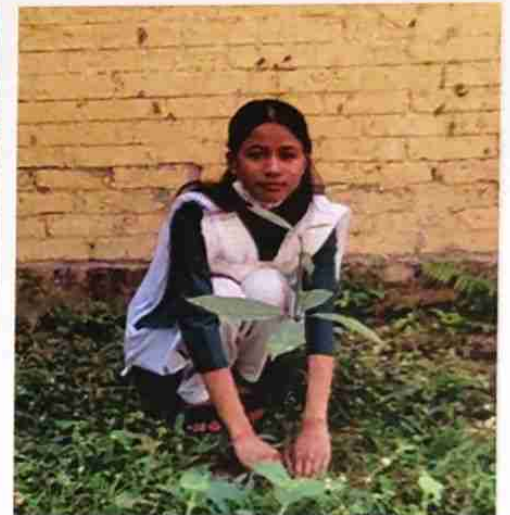
## VERMICOMPOSTING UNIT

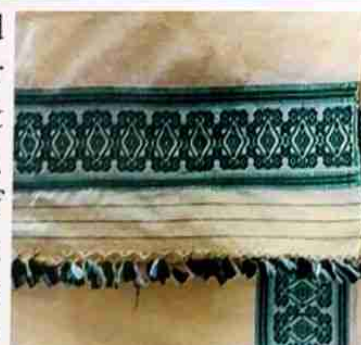
## TREE PLANTATION
